#### Deepen your understanding of key issues.

**AAUW Boise Area (ID)** branch hosted a conversation with a parent of a transgender youth to explore gender identity, current state and federal laws, and how to be a better advocate.

**AAUW Manhattan (KS)** branch hosted city commissioners and staff from the U.S. Senator's office for a roundtable discussion on AAUW's mission and AAUW of Kansas legislative priorities.

#### Build coalitions and be allies.

AAUW Indiana County (PA) branch partnered with a local theater for a free public screening of *Ratified*, a documentary on Virginia's ratification of the Equal Rights Amendment. AAUW Birmingham (AL) branch visited the Hispanic and Immigration Center of Alabama (HICA) to learn how they support immigrant families with community resources.

#### Engage in the policy process.

**AAUW of California** launched a School Board Project to mobilize members to speak out at school board meetings against book banning, curriculum censorship, and anti-LGBTQ+ policies.

**AAUW Northwest Valley (AZ)** branch trained members on the state's "Request to Speak" program, enabling them to submit comments and request to speak on bills in committee.

**AAUW of Virginia** holds an annual lobby day at the state capitol to educate lawmakers on AAUW issues, including public education, paid sick leave, abortion rights, and voting rights.
